What to bring

In warmer months (generally June to September) swimsuit with cover up, shorts, shirt, sunscreen, hat, and water bottle are essential. There may be cool, early morning fog so layering is best.

In cooler months quick-drying layers like breathable water proof pants, under armor and a dry shell are great for keeping warm and dry.

Water shoes are not essential but are preferred by many of our guests. Others prefer flip flops or paddling barefoot.



Dry sacks or ziplock bags are highly recommended to protect cell phones, cameras and other valuables.



Upon Arrival

Most of our launch locations do not have changing facilities, so come prepared to get into the water. Upon arrival, your group will be fitted for life vests, given paddles and fit for kayaks or SUPs. Most of our fleet consists of sit-on-top and tandem kayaks and stand up paddle boards that are stable and well-suited for beginners. All have small areas to secure water bottles and other belongings.

Your specific tour will determine your meeting point and/or launch site. Details for your group will be included in your confirmation.



Distances for NVP paddle routes:

Carneros Estuary Round Trip 3.15 miles. Add 1.5 miles round trip, if launching from Cuttings Wharf

Kennedy Park to Downtown Napa One way, 2.5 miles. Add 1.5 miles if paddling into Oxbow Preserve

China Point to Milliken Creek Round Trip, 4 miles.

Cuttings Wharf to Napa Valley Yacht Club One way, 5.5 miles.

Over the years, we've carefully curated some of the most authentic Napa Valley culinary experiences—designed to be enjoyed riverside before launch, mid-paddle on a secluded shoreline, or upon arrival at your final destination.

Boxed Lunch & Charcuterie Platter

A thoughtfully prepared selection of artisan sandwiches, seasonal salads, fresh fruit, and non-alcoholic beverages, made with **locally sourced organic ingredients**—perfect for paddlers who want simplicity without compromise.

House-cured artisan meats include chorizo, salumi, and pâté (when available), paired with pickled accoutrements, olives, seasonal jams or relishes, **Cowgirl Creamery cheeses**, crackers, and fresh bread.

Private Chef Experience

In true surf & terroir style, Chef Dan Gomez has been laser-focused on seafood since winning Food Network's Chopped BBQ Championship over a decade ago.

Trained at The French Laundry, Manresa, and La Toque, his menus feature dry-aged albacore, Salt Point Pacific cod, and Tomales Bay Dungeness crab—often caught personally by the chef and NVP's owner.

WHAT TO BRING

Summer Beach Attire



Clothing Materials: Non-cotton, synthetic is advised. Lycra, Nylon, Spandex, and Microfiber. Biking, Yoga, and workout apparel for example are usually blends of these non-natural fibers. Avoid Cotton.

Fit: Good, on-the-water apparel is generally snugger fitting than standard leisure wear. Keeping the apparel close to the body increases warmth and reduces wind drag.

Footware: Bring flip flops or strapped sandals. Water shoes are recommended. Tennis Shoes will be fine.

***Winter paddling, mornings and the sunset hour:** can be brisk. Dress in layers. Base layer underneath a long sleeve shirt, vest and waterproof outer layer.

Also Recommended



Waterproof Phone Case: We don't want you to lose your phone. We don't guarantee it will float! Dry boxes are available upon request.

Water Bottle: A necessity if you're paddling for long periods of time. There is no place to stop for water in the marshes.

Sun Screen: You'll be on the water for quite a while. We recommend protecting your skin.

Hat: Additional sun protection is very important on the water.

Sunglasses: Protect your eyes from glare and water shimmer.

Chums: Don't lose your favorite pair of shades. They may slip off while paddling.

All items above are available for sale in our shop so don't be worried if you forget to bring something.
